## Organ Library News

On Monday, January 26, at Boston University's Marsh Chapel, the Organ Library sponsored a presentation by Craig Whitney, assistant managing editor of the *New York Times* and author of *All the Stops*. His talk was illustrated by pictures gathered and projected by John Bishop. Mr. Whitney brought to life the vivid personalities of the players (E. Power Biggs, Virgil Fox) and builders (E. M. Skinner, G. Donald Harrison) of the twentieth century. He made a plea to organists to bring the instrument and its music back to the mainstream public by broadening the repertoire performed on concert programs (some less serious music) and revealing their own understanding of the music by talking to the audience.

The Organ Library Webcatalog has made considerable progress. By the end of January data entry had been completed through the letter "M." Eventually, it will be possible to search the Library's holdings from any computer in the world and even find compositions (e.g., chorale preludes) hidden in collections. The Library is always interested in donations of organ music—either a few pieces or large collections.
