## **BAGO Programs, 2011-2012**

Details for next season are still in the works, but here's a sneak preview:

Cristina Bañegas, from Uruguay, will present a recital as our opening program Saturday evening, September 24.

Columbus Day, Monday morning and afternoon, October 10, we'll hold a mini convention (idea, format, and procedures unabashedly borrowed from the Merrimack Valley Chapter) with a variety of workshop and educational sessions.

Sunday, January 22, Choral Evensong at Church of the Advent, Boston, with music director Mark Dwyer speaking afterward about Evensong/Vespers and how such services could be done in your context.

Saturday morning, April 28, workshop with Philippe Lefebvre (one of the three titulaire organists, Notre-Dame de Paris) in conjunction with his Friday, April 27, recital at Old West Church, Boston.

Other programs include a joint workshop on hymn playing with the Worcester Chapter; a continuation of the successful Bach Birthday Celebration in March at First Lutheran Church, Boston; a recital by a very distinguished American artist; and . . . stay tuned. The updated list with details will be sent by e-mail and posted on our website.
