Marsh Chapel and the Boston chapter of the American Guild of Organists warmly invite you to a service in celebration of the life and legacy of Max Miller, the guiding musical spirit of Boston University from 1949-1991.

Max Miller served on the faculties of the School of Music and the School of Theology at Boston University for forty-two years until his retirement in 1991. He was simultaneously University Organist, Director of Music at Marsh Chapel, Director of the Master of Sacred Music program, conductor of the Seminary Singers, and Professor of Organ in the School of Music. His legacy extends far beyond Commonwealth Avenue in the countless students who grew into today's finest church musicians throughout the country.

Joel Sheveloff, Professor Emeritus of the School of Music, will offer spoken remembrances, and organists from Max's four decades at Marsh Chapel will present musical tributes. The Marsh Chapel Choir will perform several of Max's compositions, and alumni are invited to join in the singing of Max's setting of 'Set me as a seal'. Details are listed below. The service is officiated by Rev. Dr. Robert Allan Hill, Dean of Marsh Chapel, and directed by Dr. Scott Allen Jarrett, Director of Music at Marsh Chapel.
