


Chapter Instrument Feature: Reservoir Church

Originally Our Lady of Pity - Casavant Frères Ltée. (Opus 993, 1923)

This instrument was built in 1923 by the Casavant company of Canada for the Notre Dame de Pitié Catholic church. It is especially notable for being dedicated by Marcel Dupre. It served this French parish of its Cambridge neighborhood until the late 1990s when the parish was closed and the building sold to what is now Reservoir Church. The instrument's 34 ranks over 3 manuals and pedal now play into the relatively live acoustic of the modified church building.
